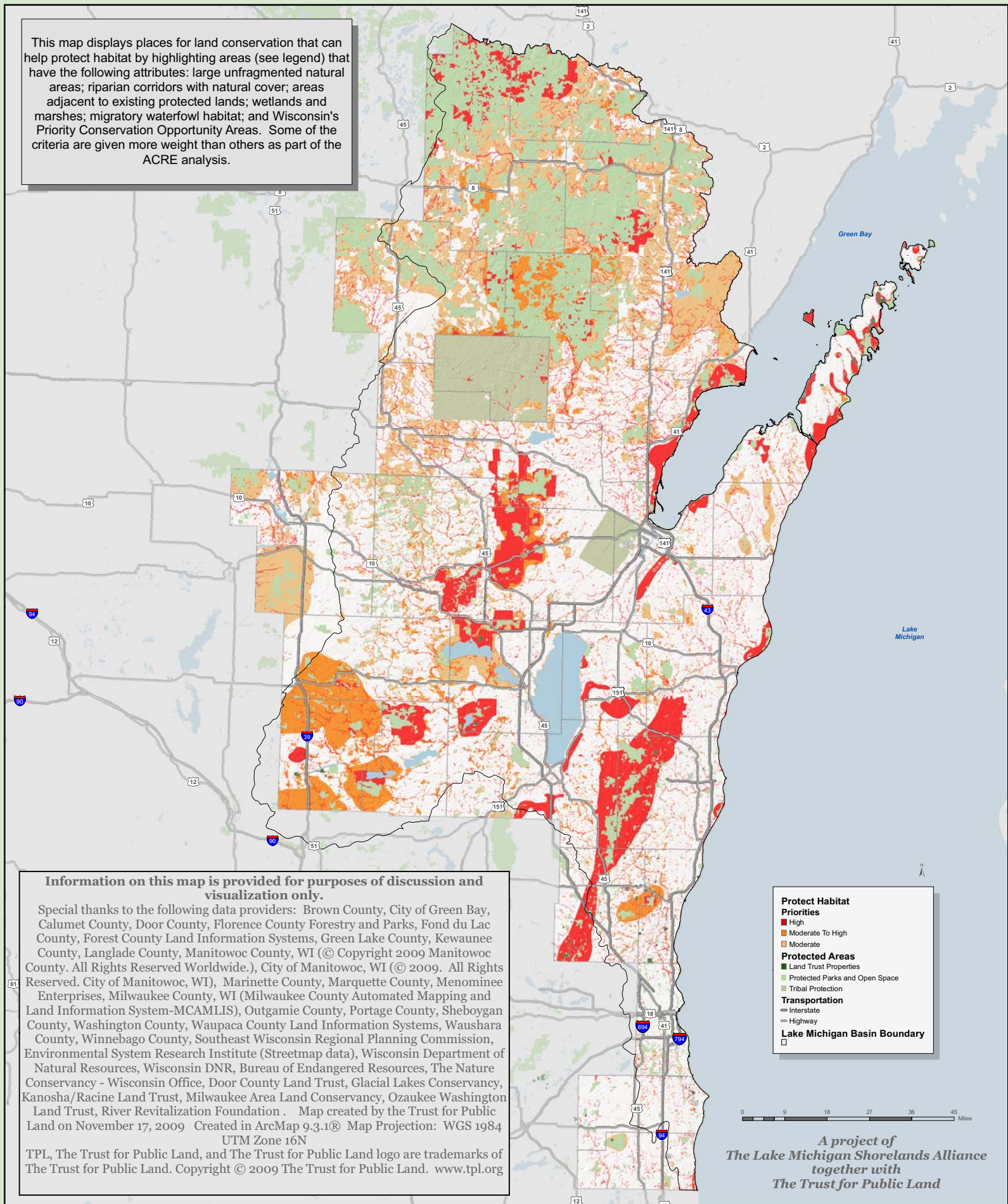


A Critical Resource Evaluation (ACRE) for the Lake Michigan Shorelands Alliance

Conservation Priority: Protect Habitat

This map displays places for land conservation that can help protect habitat by highlighting areas (see legend) that have the following attributes: large unfragmented natural areas; riparian corridors with natural cover; areas adjacent to existing protected lands; wetlands and marshes; migratory waterfowl habitat; and Wisconsin's Priority Conservation Opportunity Areas. Some of the criteria are given more weight than others as part of the ACRE analysis.
